## Council-Church partnership to brief public on "How to help the homeless"

A briefing meeting for church members and the general public will be held on **Thursday 7th June (7-8.30pm) at OBC** to advise on statutory and community services available to support people vulnerable to homelessness.

The briefing is arranged by CTiO and Rutland County Council. Town churches and the council worked in partnership last winter to support homeless people in Oakham.

Rev'd Canon Leo Osborn, Chair of CTiO, said, "Most of us have had the experience of seeing someone in need, but not knowing how best to help them. Everyone vulnerable to homelessness needs understanding and support, so churches and RCC are stepping forward to enable us to learn about the help that is available and the part we can play."
