





This Week... The Sower

Jesus told the crowd a story. "A farmer went out to plant some seeds, as he scattered the seed some fell on the path, the birds flew down and ate the seed. Some fell between the rocks, the seed started to grow but there was not enough soil for the roots, so the plants wilted. Some fell among the thorns the plants grew but were chocked by the thorns. Some fell on the fertile soil, the plants grew, and a good crop was harvested." The disciples asked Jesus to explain the meaning of the parable. "The seed is God's word, and the farmer is the one sharing God's word. Some people are like the path they hear God's word, but it is taken away from them. Some people are like the rocky soil, hearing God's word, at the beginning but give up on it. The thorns are like people hearing God's word but other things in their life chokes it. Some people are like the fertile soil with an open heart ready to act on God's word. Their life is like a good harvest."
